Eagle Rock, Chimney Rock State Park

As of May 2018, we are proud to announce the first ever expanded climbing access within Chimney Rock State Park. Call the park office for parking permits (828-625-9611). The park will provide parking and driving directions. Parking permits are needed due to limited parking (8 spaces). Display permit in your windshield. Do not park illegally as this will threaten access and likely result in a tow/ ticket. Respect neighboring private property. The trail and access was made possible by the close partnership of the Carolina Climbers Coalition, Chimney Rock State Park, and Conserving Carolina. The Tunnel Trail was partially made possible by grants from REI and American Alpine Club Cornerstone Conservation Grant. The CCC will continue to perform stewardship days in the area, please join us. Weed Patch Mt. Trail

The Weed Patch Mountain Trail continues for nearly 9 miles, connecting with Buffalo Creek Park. There are many bouldering opportunities along the trail. Buffalo Creek Park has 40+ established boulder problems. Thanks to the town of Lake Lure, Conserving Carolina, and the CCC for access to these resources!

Upper Tier Eagle Rock: 10+ routes (5.9-5.13, 4 minute walk from permitted parking)

North Side Eagle Rock: 5+ routes (5.6-5.10, 25 minute walk)

Lower Tier Eagle Rock: 20+ routes (5.8-5.12?, 25 minute walk)

B= Bouldering potential

Note: Eagle Rock was highly affected by the 2017 fires. Additionally, climbing has been closed here for 15 years. Holds will need a dusting off. Bolt replacement work has started. Chip in and help: carolinaclimbers.org
